Goodbye Sarah

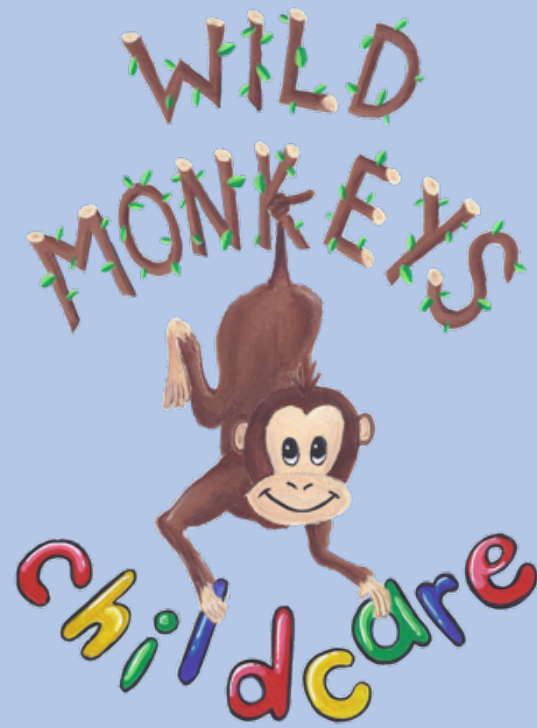
